As a result, there is a possibility that we will not get recertified before the lapse of the current certificate (which is set to expire on December 12th, 2020).

While we are working towards having the certificate in place as soon as possible, please note that the expiration of the certificate **will not** directly impact the security measures taken at Leaseweb. The information security management system will remain in place no matter what, even if the certificate expires. All the processes that are maintained in this system will also still be performed as well as any technical and/or organizational measures that are needed or required.
